Please pray for the camps at the end of November. We partner with Island Breeze MB as they are on outreach in Fiji and Australia.
We hope to start training 8 students at the beginning of February. Three have already expressed interest. School is for 5 months: 3 months in classroom and 2 months of outreach. Construction is underway for building the boys/girls dorm.
The sugar cane harvest for the ministry land was a great time of outreach and relationship building with the Hindu farmers in the area. It's been challenging, yet exciting, as it was our first time figuring out how to be farmers in ministry.
