Chad and Patricia Reimer: Fiji-- Adventure Kids Camps

We are able to host the following because of the incredible harvest and personal donations made by the generous and kind help in this difficult farming season.

- 1) 6 Bases (approximately 600 kids) are ready to start in the months of November and December, with the first camp running Nov.18-22. This will be our 3rd time hosting camps for 2019 and the 11th year of camping ministry. Pray especially for the Muslim and Hindu Base. Patricia will be in Fiji for this camp and our prayer is that a church will be built as a result of camps. We anticipate exciting, powerful movement of God's Spirit.
- 2) Jaco van der Westhuizen will be training our staff on "Farming God's Way" as we transition out of sugarcane to vegetable farming. Pray for Chad and Jaco as they prepare for the farmers' outreach on December 15th - 23rd.
- 3) Solomon Islands - Exciting news!! The school building is now complete. We are working towards building the first hospital for the unreached tribes. Two of our staff will return to the Solomon Islands in January to live with these tribes for 3 months.
- 4) Ministry truck - We said farewell to the 25-year old truck that has served the ministry well over the last 7 years. We urgently seek another one before camps start, God willing. We thank the strengthening work of the Holy Spirit both in the lives of donors and the missionaries that are ready to go and live out the Gospel with those who have not heard of Jesus. God bless you all.
